Etymology 1

Pronunciation

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Noun

أَهْلٌ ('ahl) *m sg, m pl* (*plural* أَهْلٌ ('ahālin) or أَهْلُونَ ('ahlūna), *plural construct state* أَهَالِي ('ahāli))

1. family, kinfolk
2. people, membership (body of members), followership (group of followers) (+ **genitive**, of)

- Azerbaijani: əhl
- Persian: اھل

1. to get married

Verb

أَهِلْ or أَهَلْ . ('ahila or 'ahala) *I, non-past* يَأْهُلُ (ya'halu)

1. to be on familiar terms (+ بـ (bi), with)
2. (transitive) to become accustomed to (a place)
