Etymology

Of uncertain origin. May stem from Proto-Indo-European *h₃erb^his (“circle, orb”), or alternatively *h₃erǵ^hi-.

Pronunciation

- (Classical) IPA^(key): /'or.bis/, ['ɔr.bɪs]

Third declension, alternative ablative singular in-*t̄* and accusative plural in-*t̄s*.
