### Etymology

From [English](#) *Utopia*, the fictional place in the book *Utopia* (1516) by [Sir Thomas More](#). Coined from [Ancient Greek](#) οὐ (*ou*, “not, no”) + τόπος (*tópos*, “place, region”).
